Examples of Alliterations A-Z

Alliterations Rule:

- Must have two or more words that are next to each other that start with the SAME SOUND.
- Your alliteration has to be based upon historical facts, not just a funny alliteration.
- All the words in this alliteration must start with the same sound (exception: it, a, an, the, with, etc.).
- Having trouble finding enough words that start with the sound you're using? Go to dictionary.com...click Thesaurus and find another word.

Can you find the alliterations in the list below? Which one is NOT an alliteration? Can you explain why?

RULE: Start with the SAME sound.

- Sheep showering. Sheep shampooing. Sheep shining shoes.
 Show me a showered and shampooed sheep with shiny shoes and I'll show you a sheep in sharp shape.
- Tiny tame tarantulas took time to taste toes.
- She saw ships sailing by.
- Karen kicked Carissa's kite.
- Can you see Karen today?
